Dues are due by March 31st.

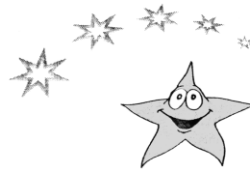
Visitors are always welcome at meetings. It is not necessary to pay dues immediately;

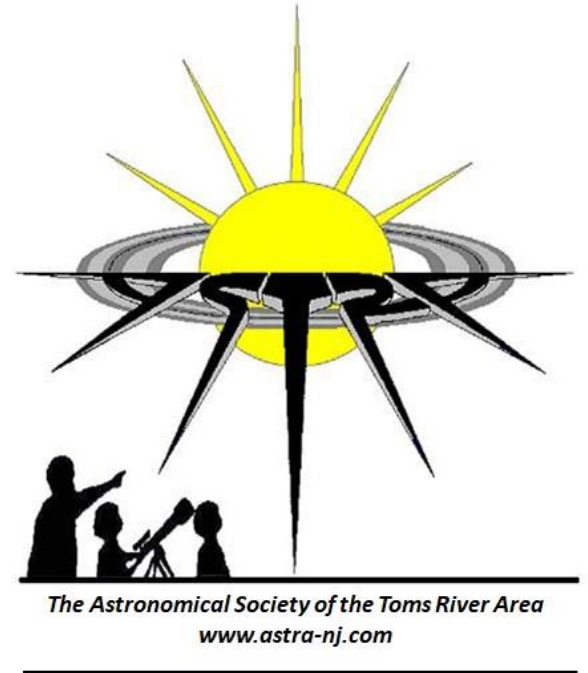
